FILM SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

FLIKS is a facilitated film and discussion program using short humanities-themed films to talk about both historical and contemporary topics of interest to Kansans. The FLIKS program will be utilized by libraries, museums, art centers, and other cultural organizations in Kansas.

Film Genres: Documentary, Narrative, Animation, or Experimental films with a humanities focus

Length: Under 15 minutes

Format: DVD (NTSC/DVD-R)

Films must be considered completed projects; works in progress will not be accepted.

Deadline (postmarked by):

Early Bird – Friday, January 15, 2010

Regular – Friday, February 12, 2010

Late – Friday, March 12, 2010

KHC anticipates reviewing and notifying filmmakers of selection by June 15, 2010.

*Films that have been previously submitted to FLIKS will not be accepted for review.

How Does the FLIKS program work?

Used by hometown cultural organizations, like public libraries, museums, and art centers, the FLIKS program will create an opportunity for Kansans across the state, in both rural and urban communities, to discuss issues of importance and interest through the screening of short films.

Each short film accepted into the FLIKS program will be paired with at least 1, but likely 2, other short films examining a similar theme (a theme like family, or the environment). A hometown organization will book a FLIKS program for a facilitated humanities discussion about the topics presented. The programs may be used by multiple organizations in multiple locations throughout the year. Each film accepted into FLIKS will be listed in an online e-catalog, included in FLIKS press releases, and promoted at both the state and local level.

The Kansas Humanities Council is a non-profit organization that creates, sponsors, and promotes humanities programs across Kansas. Through the humanities — history, literature, philosophy, and related areas — we gain understanding of where we've been, who we are, and what we've valued over time and across generations. In 2008, KHC sponsored more than 780 programs in 115 Kansas communities. These programs included book discussions, speakers bureau presentations, museum exhibitions, and community-created and grant-funded local humanities events.
