**Kansas Humanities Council Seeks Board Members**

**TOPEKA** — The Kansas Humanities Council is currently seeking nominations of Kansans for service on its 22-member Board of Directors. Nominations are due by March 31, 2011.

According to Jay Price, chair of the Membership committee, "Kansas Humanities Council board members make a difference in bringing great programs and resources to our state. If you or someone you know is passionate about the role of the humanities in Kansas, consider a nomination to the KHC Board of Directors."

The KHC Board of Directors is a volunteer board. Members have financial oversight of the organization, take an active and participatory role in fundraising, set policy, and promote awareness of the council. Board members serve for a three-year term with the possibility of renewal for a second three-year term. Meetings of the full board are held three times a year in locations across the state.

The Kansas Humanities Council is a non-profit organization that supports community-based cultural programs, serves as a financial resource through an active grant-making program, and encourages Kansans to participate in their communities.
